

HIGH STAKES

'Pairs' Horsemanship Class

Horizon Equine Facility is excited to bring a new opportunity to youth riders. At our Annual Spring Horse Show in June 2010, we have created a horsemanship class that encompasses entertainment, horsemanship and community support to fund a youth education scholarship. This class is first created by auctioning off the 'Paired Teams', that wish to ride in the horsemanship class, to the prospective 'Buyers' – the spectators. Each Pair of riders must be 'bought' by a bidder to enter the class with at least a minimum bid of \$20. Once all the paired riders have been sold and the auction is closed, the class will proceed under the show Judge's command and run as usual in accordance with the show format and HCBC rules. The Judge will place the class.

The 'auctioneer' will 'sell' each paired team to the crowd to the best of his/her ability.
Create excitement! The more money we raise, the higher the stakes!

The class proceeds will be divided as follows:

\$300 Youth Scholarship (to be awarded to the winner on show day)

Balance of 'Auction Proceeds' to be split:

- 50% 'Pairs' Class winner (as determined by the judge)
- 50% Buyer of the winning team

EXAMPLE:

6 teams are 'bought' and therefore can enter the High Stakes Class.
The total auction proceeds from all the teams 'sold' in the auction is \$700.
Team #69 win the class. Buyer #2 bought *Team # 69* in the auction.

Total Auction Proceeds	\$700	
Less: Scholarship	(\$300)	
Balance	<u>\$400</u>	
50% of balance to Team #69	↳	\$200
50% of balance to Buyer #2	↳	\$200
