Horizon Equine Facility is excited to bring a new opportunity to youth riders. At our Annual Spring Show in June 2010, we have created a horsemanship class that encompasses entertainment, horsemanship and community support to fund a Youth Education Scholarship.

The Youth Scholarship has been established to assist a deserving youth competitor reach their educational goals

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a BC Kootenay/ Columbia resident in their final 2 years of high school.
 2. Applicant must be an active horse enthusiast involved in western riding competitions. (IE: Western Pleasure, Reining, Gymkhana, Rodeo, etc.)
 3. Applicants must submit a completed application form, 800 word essay and a recent photograph of themselves at a recent competition.
Essay Topic: What does Horsemanship mean to you?
 4. Applications will be reviewed by an appointed scholarship committee and the winner will be announced at the Horizon Spring Show June 13th after the High Stakes class is placed.
 5. Applicants give permission to have their essays and photographs placed on Horizon's website
 6. Proof of post-secondary registration will be required prior to payment of scholarship.
 7. Scholarship will be held for up to 4 years after award for those applicants not entering into post-secondary education immediately upon graduation from high-school.
- . **The Scholarship Committee will select one candidate from applications received by May 31st , 2010.**
